The position of ASCSU Director of Finance is an extremely complex and laborious job and requires a great deal of time and dedication to complete; and,
WHEREAS:
Unlike every other department of the current ASCSU Cabinet there is no position for an Associate Director to assist the Director of Finance; and,
WHEREAS:
There is a definite need for such a position to exist to allow for the training and mentoring of younger students in the area of finance and student fees and to reduce the current workload of the ASCSU Director of Finance; and,
WHEREAS:
Section 106 of the ASCSU Constitution requires that “All officials of ASCSU shall be responsible for the duties specified in the job description for their office”; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED:

That the attached job description is hereby accepted for the position of Assistant Director of Finance; and,
THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED:
That a copy of this job description be placed on the ASCSU Website; and,
THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED:
That a copy of this legislation and job description be forwarded to the ASCSU Vice President, ASCSU Senate Speaker Pro Tempore, ASCSU Senate Parliamentarian, the ASCSU Director of Finance, and the ASCSU President.
