ABSTRACT: This bill to approve the resource request from Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. to fund their keynote speaker, Melissa Harris-Perry, during “CSU’s Black History Month”. As per the Constitution, Senate approval is needed for BSOF requests exceeding \$10,000.

WHEREAS

Per Section 805 of the ASCSU Constitution: The Board for Student Organization Funding may approve allocations, not to exceed \$10,000 for any one eligible organization. If a specific request exceeds \$10,000, it must be ratified by the Senate through a Bill following the Board’s recommendation. Funding requests presented to Senate must be accompanied by an itemized budget. Any request brought forth in the form of a Bill to ratify Student Funding Board Allocations must be approved by the Senate in a viewpoint neutral manner; and,

WHEREAS

The request from Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. is over the \$10,000 limit; and,

WHEREAS

The Director of Finance is forwarding the recommendation of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. application to the Senate for approval. The application received a vote of 9-0-0 from the Board for Student Organization Funding. Therefore, it was awarded at the full request pending Senate approval.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That \$15,000 be allocated to Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. for their keynote speaker, Melissa Harris-Perry, during "CSU's Black History Month" from the Board for Student Organization Funding account to be spent in accordance with the attached budget as amended and in accordance with Student Funding Board and ASCSU guidelines; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED/RESOLVED


