ASCSU WANTS TO HAVE A DISCUSSION ABOUT NON-TENURE TRACK FACULTY**

**WHEREAS:**

ASCSU is the voice of all students, graduate and undergraduate, that attend Colorado State University; and,

**WHEREAS:**

Colorado State University is a distinguished and world recognized institute for research, higher education, and achievement; and,

**WHEREAS:**

The main purpose of Colorado State University is to provide a high quality and valuable education for the students who attend this university; and,

**WHEREAS:**

A major part of the value of a degree from Colorado State University is found in the classes that are taught and in the work that the faculty bring, who teach the classes; and,

**WHEREAS:**

Colorado State University has increased the number of Non-Tenure Track Faculty responsible for teaching the growing population of students at CSU and currently over forty-four percent of undergraduate credit hours are taught by Non-Tenure Track Faculty; and,

**WHEREAS:**

Non-Tenure Track Faculty typically do not have the same salary, privileges, access to academic freedom, and job security that Tenure Track Faculty enjoy; and,

**WHEREAS:**

In his Fall 2013 address and again in an email on February 25th to CSU, Dr. Anthony Frank expressed his commitment to improving the environment and workplace equality for Non-Tenure Track Faculty; and,

**WHEREAS:**

Because this pledge and the potential outcomes associated with this pledge have the potential to affect all students of this university it stands to reason that this is a conversation that the students of Colorado State University should support and participate in; so,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:**

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University formally calls for a discussion about the future of Non-Tenure Track Faculty at Colorado State University; and,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That this discussion shall include the representatives of the CSU Administration, the Faculty Council, the Committee on Non-Tenure Track Faculty, the students of Colorado State University, and all other university stakeholders; and,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to Dr. Anthony Frank; the CSU Board of Governors; Dr. Henry Miranda; Dr. Mary Stromberger; Dr. Jennifer Aberle; Dr. Stephanie Clemons; Dr. Robert Keller; the CSU Council of Deans; the CSU Faculty Council; the Committee on Non-Tenure Track Faculty; Samantha Guinn; Lance Li Puma; the Rocky Mountain Collegian
