 - Shared Governance Task Force-

 of the institution up amongst the folks involved, and we are all going to do some research
 and come back together in two weeks.
 - Associate Justice Appointment-
 - I have appointed Kristen Schierman to fill the recently vacated Associate Justice position. Kristen will be up for ratification this coming Wednesday.
 - Positive Impact Revamp-
 - Deputy Chief of Staff Martel and I met with Dr. Blanche Hughes to discuss our request to take a look at Positive Impact, and provide recommendations for any changes for next fall.
 We will continue these conversations with all stakeholders of the program, and ultimately provide recommended changes in the coming weeks.
