**WHEREAS**

Article I, Section 106 of the Associated Students of Colorado State University Constitution reads as follows:

“Section 106: All officials of ASCSU shall be responsible for the duties specified in the job description for their office. No office shall exist without an accompanying job description. Job descriptions shall be created or changed only by the action of a bill passed by the Senate and approved by the President;” and,

**WHEREAS**

Article III, Section 302 of the Associated Students of Colorado State University Constitution reads as follows:

“...The President shall prepare an executive budget, which shall be submitted to the Senate for deliberation and apportionment, with no more than 10.5% of the total budgeted expenditures allocated for salaries, excluding the ASCSU Administrative Assistant and any non-ratified positions...”; so,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED**

That the ASCSU Senate formally adopts the attached executive and legislative job descriptions; and,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED**

That the ASCSU Senate formally allocates \$2,103,768.44 from the Senate General Fund for the 2015 – 2016 fiscal year to be spent in accordance with the attached budget.
