ABSTRACT: This Bill is aimed at the creation of a task force involving the three branches of ASCSU; the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative. This task force would be created in order to evaluate the ASCSU Constitution in its current form and suggest necessary changes in the form of a bill to be submitted to the ASCSU Senate for evaluation. This task force would comprise of no less than five members throughout the three branches.

"All proposed amendments must specifically delineate the exact changes being proposed."; and,

Bill 4501 conversely violated Roberts Rules of Order by failing to notify the Senate in advance about a Constitutional change; and,

WHEREAS

That the task force use the proposed changes to the document attached to Bill 4501 as a point of reference; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED
