ABSTRACT: This resolution seeks to honor CSU student Savannah McNealy, who was killed in a shooting near campus, by encouraging the CSU Administration to rename the “Ram Walk” the “McNealy Ram Walk”.

WHEREAS

Last week, a member of our community lost her life in a shooting near campus; and,

WHEREAS

Savannah McNealy was an integral part of the CSU community involved in the Rocky Mountain Student Media Corp and the CSU Creative Services Team, and played a key role in the design of the Ram Walk leading into the new stadium; and,

WHEREAS

In the words of CSU President Tony Frank,

“The circumstances around her death do not, indeed, cannot define Savannah’s life. Her life’s definition is etched on all those who knew and cared for her via the impact she had on them. She left her stamp on CSU as well, and we will treasure her memory.”

;and,

WHEREAS

The ASCSU Senate believes that Rams take care of Rams; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That the ASCSU Senate strongly recommends that the CSU administration renames the “Ram Walk” leading to the stadium, the “McNealy Ram Walk”; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to the CSU Creative Services Team, CSU President Tony Frank, CSU Provost Rick Miranda, Vice President for Student Affairs Blanche Hughes, Dean of Students Jody Donovan;
