ABSTRACT: This resolution requests that the lights and massive screen on the CSU Stadium be turned off when not in use for a game or special event.

WHEREAS

Colorado State University professes to be an environmentally sustainable institution; and,

WHEREAS

Colorado State University is a Platinum rated university on the STARS scale and aims to retain that title; and,

WHEREAS

Colorado State University has committed to 100% renewable energy usage by 2030 and ought to pursue that goal by any measure; and,

WHEREAS

Numerous students have voiced concerns about the waste associated with the stadium's lighting at unnecessary hours; and,

WHEREAS

The light from the stadium is disruptive to residents near the stadium, particularly in Academic Village at night; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That the ASCSU Senate urges the University Administration to order the extinguishing of all unnecessary lighting and use of the massive screen in the stadium at all times other than game days or otherwise active usages of the stadium; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to Tony Frank, President of Colorado State University; Joe Parker, Director of Athletics; Lynn Johnson, Vice President for University Operations; Doug Max, Senior Associate A.D. for Facilities & Event Management
