ABSTRACT: Currently CSU has limited data regarding the level of poverty-related insecurities within the student body. This resolution would display the student body's desire to annually gather data regarding food insecurity and housing insecurity within our student body.

WHEREAS

The students of Colorado State University feel the impact of food and housing insecurity on a daily basis; and,

WHEREAS

The institution of Colorado State University does not have up-to-date statistics on the population of students impacted by poverty-related insecurities; and,

WHEREAS

Past research in this area has not included comprehensive data on the different levels of these insecurities; and,

WHEREAS

Past research has not investigated the intersectionality of the different poverty based insecurities; and,

WHEREAS

Current research is needed to more effectively address these insecurities on campus and create programming targeted at aiding students for long-term solutions; and,

WHEREAS

The city of Fort Collins has requested aid in understanding poverty based insecurities within the Colorado State University campus; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University support the annual collection of current and up to date information about the presence of poverty-based insecurities in the campus community; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That this data is shared with the Associated Students of Colorado State University and the City of Fort Collins Department of Social Sustainability as the annual report is made available; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That this resolution be sent to President Tony Frank, VP of Student Affairs David McKelfresh, RHA President Kyra Ferguson, and Jennifer J. Johnson.
