ABSTRACT: A bill providing funding for additional furniture for the SDPS Offices.

#### **WHEREAS**

CSU policies restrict where furniture can be bought, leaving only two vendors, who have high cost furniture and.

#### WHEREAS

The Student Diversity and Program Services (SDPS) offices receiving funding through this bill do not receive student fee money and,

#### **WHEREAS**

Students frequenting these SDPS offices have requested specific replacements to old and/or damaged furniture. Much of the furniture in SDPS offices have been handed down to these offices and/or are very dated and,

## **WHEREAS**

ASCSU has talked extensively about supporting diverse identities, and this bill provides tangible means to do so and,

#### WHEREAS

Providing furniture for SDPS offices alleviates financial stresses on them, allowing their resources to be directed to programs and services. Additionally, this increases physical comfort in these spaces, and shows support for the students who frequent them, and

### WHEREAS

All students are welcome and able to use these offices, even if they do not identify with the identities represented by an office. The furniture requested will be placed in the common spaces of these offices, allowing all students to use them so,

#### THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That senate shall use a total of twenty four thousand, and twenty four dollars [\$24,023.42] from the Senate general discretionary fund to the SDPS cluster, through allocating the Pride Resource Center ten thousand and seventy eight dollars [\$10,077.64]; El Centro seven thousand, five hundred and thirty dollars [\$7,530]; Black/African American Cultural Center four thousand, six hundred and eight dollars [\$4,607.96]; The Asian Pacific American Cultural Center three hundred and five dollars [\$305] and the Native American Cultural Center one thousand, five hundred, and three dollars [\$1,503]. that will be used to replace old and damaged furniture and,

### THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That the SDPS offices will use this funding for the following items, which are further described on the attached spreadsheet:

Pride Resource Center -- 5 armchairs, 2 couches, 2 ottomans and 1 tables

El Centro – 16 chairs, 1 sofa, 3 tables, and 1 conference table

Black/African American Cultural Center -- 4 chairs, and 4 sofa chairs

Native American Cultural Center -- 6 chairs

Asian Pacific American Cultural Center – 1 Table

## THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

Should one office go under budget, those funds can be allocated to another office going over budget. Furniture not listed above or over the quantity above cannot be bought. These offices

understand ASCSU will not fund over total listed above. Any remaining unused funds will be transferred back to the Senate Discretionary Fund and,

## THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to the respective faculty for the Pride Resource Center, El Centro, The Black/African American Cultural Center, The Native American Cultural Center, The Asian Pacific American Cultural Center, and Kathy Sisneros, Vice President of Student Affairs..
