**A DECREASE IN THE AMOUNT AN INDIVIDUAL STUDENT ORGANIZATION MAY RECEIVE  
FROM THE STUDENT FUNDING BOARD**

WHEREAS: The current demand for funding through the Student Funding Board far outstrips the resources available; and,

WHEREAS: The 37<sup>th</sup> Senate of ASCSU amended the Bylaws of the Student Funding Board to limit the amount of money a student organization can request from the Student Funding Board to \$20,000; and,

WHEREAS: This was the first actual limit placed on student organization requests from the Student Funding Board and represents the first effort at curtailing excessive requests; and,

WHEREAS: Several student organizations have received in excess of \$15,000 this year, draining the funds available; and,

WHEREAS: Slightly decreasing the total funds available to each organization would make more funding available for a greater number of student organization funding proposals.

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED**

That Article V, Section 2.9 of the Bylaws of the Student Funding Board is amended to read as follows:

Student organizations are eligible to obtain up to ~~\$20,000~~ **15,000** each year from Student Funding Board. Any requests that surpass this cap or any single request exceeding \$9,999.99 must be ratified by the Senate through a bill following the Board's recommendation. Funding requests presented to Senate must be accompanied by an itemized budget. Any request brought forth in the form of a Bill to ratify Student Funding Board allocations must be approved by the Senate in a viewpoint neutral manner.
