WHEREAS: Historically RLT members have been ratified as members of the Executive Branch; and,

WHEREAS: RLT members do not meet all the requirements for ratification into the executive branch therefore are not confined to exclusive participation in one branch; and,

WHEREAS: As stated by the Constitution in Article 1, Section 104, no ASCSU member can hold positions in two branches simultaneously; and,

WHEREAS: The purpose of Ram Leadership Team is to foster the leadership of first and second year students with in ASCSU as a whole, not exclusive to the Executive Branch.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the Ram Leadership Team is a leadership development program housed by the Executive Branch, allowing RLT members to participate in multiple branches simultaneously in order to fulfill the program's purpose; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED


That members of RLT shall not be considered or ratified as members of the Executive Branch.
