Amending the FY12 Long Bill**

WHEREAS: The Board of Governors approved the Lory Student Center Renovation project on October 5, 2011; and,

WHEREAS: Perkins and Will, the architects in charge of the Lory Student Center Renovation plan, has determined the Lory Student Center Renovation project can be completed by the Fall of 2014; and,

WHEREAS: The cost estimate provided by Rider, Levett & Bucknell indicates that approximately \$4 million can be saved by completing the Lory Student Center Renovation Project in one phase rather than extending over two phases; and,

WHEREAS: The 31st enacted clause of the FY12 Long Bill (Bill #4016) reads:
“That the Fortieth Senate of the Associated Students of Colorado State University approves the SFRB recommendation to allow the Lory Student Center a bonding capacity of \$60 million (total project cost not to exceed \$65 million) to be reduced accordingly by secured donations, that a fee not to exceed \$79 to be implemented upon project completion (earliest Fall 2015)”;

WHEREAS: The Student Fee Review Board and the Lory Student Center Governing Board have approved the change that the fee increase begins earliest Fall of 2014.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the 31st enacted clause of Bill #4016 be amended to read:

“That the Fortieth Senate of the Associated Students of Colorado State University approves the SFRB recommendation to allow the Lory Student Center a bonding capacity of \$60 million (total project cost

not to exceed \$65 million) to be reduced accordingly by secured donations, that a fee not to exceed \$79 \$70 to be implemented upon project completion (earliest Fall 2015-2014)", to reflect the change in the development plan to not phase the Lory Student Center project, and;

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to Dr. Tony Frank, Colorado State University President; and Dr. Blanche Hughes, Vice President for Student Affairs.
