*ABSTRACT: This bill reallocates funds from the payroll discretionary (and the ASCSU fund balance) to properly reflect summer pay for the Court positions, reinstate some funding to the Department of Graduate Affairs, and adjust funds allocated to the Department of Environmental Affairs.*

**WHEREAS**

According to Article IX, Section 902 of the ASCSU Constitution: "Funds may be transferred between ASCSU departments by the President, only with the approval of Senate in the form of a Supplemental Funding Bill that shall be written and presented by the President and/or their designee"; and,

**WHEREAS**

Under Section 902 of the ASCSU Constitution, "Multiple transfer may be presented in one Bill"; so,



**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED/ENACTED**

That upon passage of this bill, the following payroll re-allocations will take place:

- \$605.80 shall be transferred from *Payroll Discretionary* line item to the *Chief Justice Summer* line item to reflect the updated Court job descriptions.
- \$159.70 shall be transferred from *Payroll Discretionary* line item to the *Chief Justice Fall/Spring* line item to reflect the updated Court job descriptions.
- \$127.02 shall be transferred from *Payroll Discretionary* line item to the *Deputy Chief Justice* line item to reflect the updated Court job descriptions.
- \$230 shall be transferred from *Payroll Discretionary* line item to the *Associate Justice* line item to reflect the updated Court job descriptions.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED/ENACTED**

That upon passage of this bill, the following budgetary re-allocations will take place:

- \$500 shall be transferred from the *ASCSU Fund Balance* to the *Graduate Affairs Discretionary Programs* line item.
- \$10,000 shall be transferred from the *Graduate Affairs Professional Development and Supply Grant* line item to the *Graduate Affairs Travel Grant for Graduate Students* line item.
- \$4,000 shall be transferred from the *ASCSU Fund Balance* to the *Graduate Affairs Travel Grant for Graduate Students* line item.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED/ENACTED**

That upon passage of this bill, the following payroll re-allocations will take place:

- \$4300 shall be transferred from *Payroll Alumni Affairs* to a new line item, *Deputy Director of Sustainability\** under Environmental Affairs.
- \$920 shall be transferred from *Payroll Discretionary* line item to a new line item, *Summer* under Payroll for Environmental Affairs.

\*The job description for this role has been approved by Senate, but the funding had not.




