

**ASCSU RAM LEADER**  
**JOB DESCRIPTION—2010-2011**

Applicants shall be members of ASCSU at the time of appointment, and shall have a cumulative GPA of no less than 2.00. Applicants shall also remain enrolled as a student throughout the regular academic year.

**ACCOUNTABLE TO:** The Students of Colorado State University via the ASCSU President, ASCSU Vice President, and the ASCSU Chief of Staff, as well as the Director, Associate Directors and Assistant Directors of Leadership Development.

**DUTIES:**

1. Attend weekly Ram Leadership Team Meetings, every Thursday from 6:30-8:30pm.
2. Attend Senate meetings once a month at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesdays, as an ex-officio member. If you cannot make the meeting, or must leave early, inform the Leadership Development Department of the reason for your absence.
3. Keep at least 1 regularly posted office hour throughout the regular work week.
4. Participate in Student Outreach, ie: gathering student opinions for both ASCSU as a whole and the senators.
5. Present a professional image of ASCSU and serve the needs of the students of Colorado State University.
6. Attend at least two programs a semester put on by a student organization, where at least one of such programs must be directly related to diversity issues and/or awareness.
7. Attend at least two University decision-making body meetings per semester.
8. Aid in facilitating monthly leadership development programming for both the Cabinet and the Senate.
9. Participate fully in the mentorship program by staying active and engaged with the department you are mentoring under.
10. Act in compliance with the ASCSU Constitution. Be responsible and representative of the needs and viewpoints of all the students at Colorado State University. Perform duties in an honest, sincere, and responsible manner.
11. Be available to assist and support the Associated Students of Colorado State University and the students of Colorado State University above and beyond the duties as described herein.
