WHEREAS: The Elections Code does not currently provide a deadline for campaigns to turn in fines for penalties; and,

WHEREAS: A deadline will help to ensure that all penalties are paid; and,

WHEREAS: There is currently no penalty designated for a campaign that refuses to pay its fines.

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED**

That Section C of Article XI of the Referenda and Elections Code is amended to read as follows:

“Section C: All fines levied against candidates and campaigns by the Elections Committee shall be counted on that candidate or campaign’s Donation and Expenditure report form. Candidates and campaigns shall be required to remit in monetary form any fine levied by the Elections Committee. Failure to remit fines within 4 business days to the Elections Manager will be a major violation. Such payment must be received no later than 5 p.m. on the 4<sup>th</sup> day. If a campaign chooses to appeal a penalty the fine will not be due until 4 days after the appeal has been settled by the Supreme Court.”
