**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**

That the Fortieth Senate of the Associated Student of Colorado State University requests that those dumbbells 95lbs and above that were removed be made available again; and,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**

That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Campus Recreation Executive Director Judy Muenchow, Campus Recreation Director of Operations Dave Frock, and CSU President Tony Frank.
