WHEREAS: Over the past several months Mr. Shirvell has engaged in acts of hatred and intimidation directed at Michigan Student Assembly President Chris Armstrong largely due to his sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS: These actions have been deemed by the University of Michigan Board of Regents sufficiently egregious to constitute an attack on the entire University body, stating, "When one member of our community is targeted, we are all attacked."; and,

WHEREAS: An attack on any higher education community likewise constitutes a threat to all communities of higher education; and,

WHEREAS: The threat posed by Mr. Shirvell has been deemed sufficiently serious by the University of Michigan Department of Public Safety that they have issued a trespass warning prohibiting Mr. Shirvell from coming onto the Ann Arbor campus; and,

WHEREAS: The notion of a high ranking state employee engaging in actions of intimidation and hatred such as these against a student leader is repugnant.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University condemns the actions of Mr. Shirvell; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University encourages Michigan Student Assembly President Chris Armstrong to stand strong in the face of this adversity; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University offers our full support to Michigan Student Assembly President Chris Armstrong; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Mike Cox, Michigan Attorney General; Chris Armstrong, President, Michigan Student Assembly; Andrew Shirvell; Assistant Michigan Attorney General; John W. Suthers, Colorado Attorney General; and Tony Frank, President, Colorado State University-Fort Collins.
