WHEREAS: Colorado State University (CSU) is experiencing record high enrollment this year and there is evidence that this trend will continue; and,

WHEREAS: Currently CSU Housing can hold around 6400 residents and has plans to add an additional 240 beds within the next few years; and,

WHEREAS: With over 26,000 undergraduate students enrolled at CSU, and with CSU planning on the undergraduate population increasing to 30,000, the university can only accommodate approximately 17% of students, and soon less; and,

WHEREAS: City zoning laws in Fort Collins are severely limiting plausible, affordable housing options for the increasing amounts of students moving up to Fort Collins.

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University supports a plan for housing that is affordable, quality, and within close proximity to CSU and tasks the Department of Community Affairs to advocate for such housing options.
