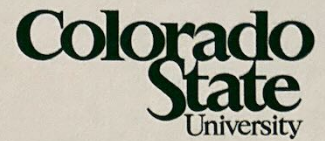

**RESOLUTION #4013
Changing the Conditions of an Unexcused Absence**

- WHEREAS:** Currently a Senator's absence in Senate is considered excused if there is an Associate Senator present to take the Senator's place; and,
- WHEREAS:** Currently a Senator can never show up for Senate and be considered as fulfilling their responsibilities as long as an Associate Senator is present; and,
- WHEREAS:** Unless we take the time to impeach all the Senators who never show up, they will hold their positions and new people will never have a chance to utilize the Senator positions; and,
- WHEREAS:** Article II, Section C of the Senate Bylaws lays out a resignation in absentia that requires 4 unexcused absences.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That Article II, Section A of the Senate Bylaws be amended to read:

"A. An unexcused absence occurs when a Senator (~~without substituting an Associate Senator~~) or a Senate officer is not present for the entire session, not to include a special session. Unexcused absences may be appealed to the Senate."

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That Section "Absenteeism", Clause 1 of the job description for ASCSU Senator be amended to read the same as above.
