Abstract: This bill aims to allocate funding of an amount of \$6,000 from the Senate Discretionary Fund, in conjunction with \$1,000 from the department of Diversity and Inclusion, in conjunction with \$2,000 from the Office of the President for the purpose of covering the administrative costs necessary for House of Ovis' Dragula Halloween Bash.

WHEREAS

The CSU Principles of Community state, “We create and nurture inclusive environments and welcome, value, and affirm all members of our community, including their various identities, skills, ideas, talents, and contributions.”; and,

WHEREAS

The Dragula Halloween Bash is a student-led drag show that is meant to be a celebration of queer joy, togetherness, and expression; and,

WHEREAS

This event is designed to be a student-focused space for expression, which will help create a stronger student community and a better environment for diverse voices across campus; and,

WHEREAS

Encouraging student involvement is vital for the retention of LGBTQIA+ students at Colorado State University. This bash will be Emcee'd in part by local performers which supports the goals of ASCSU and CSU to keep the Fort Collins and Campus communities working together; and,

WHEREAS

House of Ovis is a new student organization on campus this year, so they do not yet have the built-in funding to support their club; and,

WHEREAS

Due to the timeline and caliber of the event and expected turnout that drag performances typically have, as well as the recency of the ratification of BSOF members, receiving funding from BSOF is not possible for these students; and,

WHEREAS

As the authors of this legislation received a request for help on this project on Monday, October 3rd, 2022, and needed to submit the request two months in advance according to the BSOF bylaws in Article VI: Funding

Rules: sub-section 17 “the request must be presented at a BSOF meeting at least 42 calendar days or 6 weeks prior to the date of the event or program start date...It is recommended to start the BSOF application process two months before the scheduled event if these financial items are at play.”, funding from BSOF is not feasible; and,

WHEREAS

The expense of the event is too high for organizers to pay out of pocket, with charges amounting to an estimated \$6,000, for the LSC Technical services and LSC catering services; and,

WHEREAS

While the specific expected costs of the event are \$6,656.10, Bills asking for money from the Senate Discretionary Fund, as well as any RFD, are both expected and sometimes even asked to be overestimated to prevent the need for additional legislation; and,

WHEREAS

This is an ASCSU-wide project, working in conjunction with the Department of Diversity and Inclusion of the ASCSU Executive Branch contributing \$3,000; and,

WHEREAS

The endorsement of ASCSU for this project falls in line with the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion initiatives of the 52nd Senate and the Long-Sandoval administration; so,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That the 52nd Senate allocates \$8,000.00 from the Senate Discretionary fund for the purposes of funding the House of Ovis Dragula Halloween Bash on October 30th, 2022; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That \$1,000.00 be allocated from the Discretionary fund of the Director of Diversity and Inclusion for the purposes of funding the House of Ovis Dragula Halloween Bask on October 30th, 2022; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That \$2,000 be allocated from the Office of the President discretionary for the purposes of funding the House of Ovis Dragula Halloween Bask on October 30th, 2022; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That any funds not spent under the passage of this Bill for the House of Ovis Dragula Halloween Bash by January 1st-31st, 2023 be returned to their respective funds, the Senate Discretionary Fund and the Diversity and Inclusion Discretionary Fund.
