**ABSTRACT:** The formatting of the ASCSU Constitution is done in such a way that makes it difficult to understand. This bill seeks to change that.

---

**WHEREAS**

The Constitution of ASCSU is our governing document and it is important, both for internal and external use, that the Constitution is easily readable; and,

**WHEREAS**

The current incarnation of the ASCSU Constitution has listing issues that makes it difficult to discern what paragraphs go with which subsections and which subsection goes with which section; and,

**WHEREAS**

Some parts of the ASCSU Constitution are left aligned and other parts are justified; and,

**WHEREAS**

The font and font size of the current Constitution do not meet ADA accessibility; and,

**WHEREAS**

These three issues concomitantly lead to a Constitution that is: hard to read, violates inclusivity guidelines, and is generally not aesthetically appealing; and,

**WHEREAS**

Fixing formatting errors would make the ASCSU Constitution easier to read, ensure the Constitution meets accessibility guidelines, and is more aesthetically pleasing; and,

**WHEREAS**

The purpose of the bill is ***ONLY*** to fix formatting errors and not any Article, Section, Subsection, Paragraph, Subparagraph, or Title; so,

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED**
