**ABSTRACT:** This bill amends the ASCSU Elections Code for the 2022 General Election

**WHEREAS**

Section 806, sub-section E of the ASCSU Constitution states, "The ASCSU Referenda and Elections Code may only be amended by a Senate bill specifically delineating all proposed amendments."

**WHEREAS**

The current incarnation of the Elections Code does not treat President/Vice President and Speaker of the Senate Campaigns equally, nor does it reflect equity for any hearing the Elections Committee has jurisdiction over, nor does it reflect ASCSU's commitment to ranked-choice voting as demonstrated in Resolution #5102.

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED**

That the Fifty-First Senate of the Associated Students of Colorado State University, approve of the edits to the Elections Code made by Manager Jenkins that are attached to this bill.

**THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED/RESOLVED**
