ABSTRACT: This bill aims to receive \$10,000 from the ASCSU General Discretionary Fund for the continuation and addition of 50 more permanent QR code wayfinding signage for All-Gender Restrooms on campus.

WHEREAS

ASCSU wrote a bill, Bill 5012: Signage Inclusivity Bill, in the 18th Session of the 50th Senate on March 17, 2021, which passed unanimously with a vote of 25-0-0; and,

WHEREAS

The CSU Principles of Community state “We create and nurture inclusive environments and welcome, value, and affirm all members of our community, including their various identities, skills, ideas, talents and contributions.”; and,

WHEREAS

Students continuously have troubling finding and accessing All-Gender Restrooms, even in the buildings that currently have All-Gender Restrooms; and,

WHEREAS

Increasing signage also increases awareness to Colorado State University's ongoing goal of having accessible All-Gender Restrooms on campus; and,

WHEREAS

CSU is actively pursuing increasing inclusion efforts on campus, with multiple UFFAB proposals requesting All-Gender Restrooms be built in buildings lacking those spaces; and,

WHEREAS

The continuation and expansion of this project require additional funding for the construction of the physical signs, as well as the yearly fees associated with trackable QR Code Analytics; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the Fifty First ASCSU Senate allocates \$10,000 towards the creation and upkeep of permanent wayfinding signage for All-Gender Restrooms on CSU campus; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That any remaining money in the All-Gender Restroom budget by the end of the Fiscal Year 2023 be returned to the ASCSU Fund Balance; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED
