Green and Gold Book Reboot

ABSTRACT: This bill seeks to find funding to recreate the 2017 ASCSU Green and Gold introduction book to create inclusion for new members both current and future.

WHEREAS

In the 2017-2018 school year, Speaker Brown created an introductory book for the entirety of ASCSU; and,

WHEREAS

This book, titled the "Green and Gold Book", gave basic information such as how a normal Senate Session runs, contact information, and ASCSU office guidelines, as well as easy access to documents that are harder to find such as the Executive Bylaws; and,

WHEREAS

The new copy of the book is to be created to be as timeless as possible to require little upkeep and merely a reprint when copies run out, rather than recreating the book after every new administration; and,

WHEREAS

The 51st Senate has continuously brought up the lack of introduction and information given to new members as they are sworn in, and the Green and Gold book creates an easy to access, and hard to forget avenue for basic information; and,

WHEREAS

Each book, through FastPrint, costs around \$10 each, and there are around 110 current members of ASCSU which comes down to \$1,200.00; and,

WHEREAS

QR code stickers, through uprinting.com, in a group of 500, cost \$30.78, which provides plenty for all members of ASCSU, with allowance for supply to give other interested parties the opportunity to receive one; and,

WHEREAS

The Executive Branch and the Judicial Branch also have a large turnover each new administration and deserve the same easy access to relevant and basic information; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That \$5,000.00 be allocated from the Senate General Discretionary Fund for the creation of the 2022 Green and Gold Book for printing for the last of the 51st Senate and for the beginning of the 52nd Senate, as well as QR code stickers to allow for environmentally friendly versions of the book; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

Members of ASCSU will be given a choice to opt in as to whether or not they would like a printed copy of the Green and Gold book with the provision for the printing of a reasonable number of extra books to be kept in the ASCSU office; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That the Recruitment and Retention Officer Job description be updated to include the new task of updating and printing the Green and Gold book prior to the Fall Retreat each year. This task shall be added as an additional bullet point at the bottom of the "Job Specific Tasks and Responsibilities" section and shall state "Update and print the Green and Gold book, as well as the QR code stickers, prior to the fall retreat. Ensure every member of ASCSU is provided with the opportunity to receive a book and/or sticker free of charge."; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That the Chief of Staff Job description be updated to include the new task of updating and printing the Green and Gold book prior to the Fall Retreat each year. This task shall be added to the "Job Specific Tasks and Responsibilities" section beneath the bullet point "Plan the ASCSU Fall Retreat at the beginning of the school year. Collaborate with the Vice President and Chief of Staff along with the ASCSU Administrative Assistant and Advisor." as an additional bullet point stating, "Work with the ASCSU Senate Recruitment and Retention officer to . update and print the Green and Gold book, as well as the QR code stickers, prior to the fall retreat. Ensure every member of ASCSU is provided with the opportunity to receive a book and/or sticker free of charge."; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That any unspent funds provided for this project at the end of fiscal year, 2023 be returned to the ASCSU Fund Balance; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED


