Funding for Lyft (RamRide Secure) codes for CSUHN

ABSTRACT: This bill is to provide \$5,500.00 from the ASCSU General Discretionary Fund to provide additional Lyft codes to the CSUHN to increase student access to healthcare on campus and for the advertisement of the same.

WHEREAS

Access to transportation is a huge impediment when accessing healthcare; and

WHEREAS

As CSUHN is at a far corner on campus, accessibility might be an issue for students, especially those with financial issues; and,

WHEREAS

Public transportation might not always be available or easily accessible to students that need healthcare; and,

WHEREAS

The purpose of this pilot program is to test the level of need for transportation to healthcare services on campus and see what best practices are for application, procedure, and program amount or quantity for Lyft rides to be (permanently) implemented starting the Fall Semester of 2022 or later; so,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the Fifty First Senate of the Associate Students of Colorado State University allocates \$5,000.00 from the ASCSU General Discretionary Fund to the Lyft pilot program associated to with RamRide Secure be initiated for the Spring Semester of 2022 that would subsidize up to \$12 per ride, or up to \$15 for accessibility purposes, to and from the CSU Health Network; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That the Fifty First Senate of the Associate Students of Colorado State University further allocates an additional \$500 for the advertisement of said scheme; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That if the \$5,500 allocated to this project is not used by December 31st of 2022 then the remaining funds shall be returned to the ASCSU Fund Balance.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That Cristina Berg of the CSU Health Network and Lindsey Mason of Off-Campus Life will oversee the installation and structure of this program forthe Spring Semester of 2022; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That this bill be sent to Joyce McConnell, CSU President; Christian Dykson, ASCSU President; Lindsay Mason, Director of Off-Campus Life; Christina Burg, CSUHN; Uriel Diaz, ASCSU accountant.
