ABSTRACT: This bill aims to correct funding timeline mistakes in the abstract of Bill #5112:
Continuing Support for Rams Against Hunger Food Pantries.

WHEREAS

Bill #5112 was passed with full support of the 51st ASCSU Senate; and,

WHEREAS

The abstract of the bill reads: “This bill will allocate \$36,000 from the ASCSU General Discretionary Fund account over two years in \$12,000 per year increments towards maintaining the success of the Rams Against Hunger Pocket Pantries that were created and originally funded by ASCSU in 2018;” and,

WHEREAS

A following clause of the bill reads: “That the Fifty-First ASCSU Senate allocates \$36,000 from the ASCSU General Discretionary Fund towards the Rams Against Hunger Pocket Pantries over the course of 3 years, with \$12,000 allocated from the fund each year starting June 2022 and ending May 31, 2025;” and,

WHEREAS

The 51st ASCSU Senate Legislation Book on the ASCSU website reads: “This bill will allocate \$30,000 from the ASCSU Senate Discretionary account over three years in \$10,000 per year increments towards maintaining the success of the Rams Against Hunger Pocket Pantries that were created and originally funded by ASCSU in 2018;” and,

WHEREAS

The abstract of Bill #5112 and 51st ASCSU Senate Legislation Book are inconsistent with both the intent of the bill and the following clause written above; so,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the abstract of Bill #5112 be corrected by the ASCSU Parliamentarian to read: “This bill will allocate \$36,000 from the ASCSU Senate Discretionary Fund account over the course of three years in \$12,000 per year increments towards maintaining the success of the Rams Against Hunger Pocket Pantries that were created and originally funded by ASCSU in 2018.”

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED


That the 51st ASCSU Senate Legislation Book be corrected by the ASCSU Parliamentarian to read: “This bill will allocate \$36,000 from the ASCSU Senate Discretionary Fund account over the course of three years in \$12,000 per year increments towards maintaining the success of the Rams Against Hunger Pocket Pantries that were created and originally funded by ASCSU in 2018.”

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That this bill be sent to Rick Miranda, CSU President; Rob Long, ASCSU President; Jessica Sholts, ASCSU Advisor; Jessica Dyrdaahl, ASCSU Advisor; Tony Frank, CSU Chancellor; and Ashton Duffield, ASCSU Accountant.
