ABSTRACT: The purpose of this bill is to grant \$6,000 from the senate discretionary fund to the ASCSU travel grant to hear student proposals on travel for academic and community benefit.

WHEREAS

Travel grant funds are below \$5,000; and,

WHEREAS

The grant has applicants requesting \$21,968.13; and the entire Grant's budget is \$20,000.

WHEREAS

The travel grant was designed to make student travel more accessible while following ethical and legal guidelines; so that up to 5 additional groups or 15 additional travelers can benefit from the Travel Grant; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That Senate transfers \$6,000 from the ASCSU Senate Discretionary Fund to the ASCSU Travel Grant Fund; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That unspent travel grant funds at the end of the fiscal year will rollover to the next fiscal year's ASCSU fund; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED
