THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That section XVII (17), titled "Announcements" of the weekly Senate agenda not be included in the agenda, as stated in the bylaws, in the capacity of being considered officially not germane, and

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That all outside branch reports be directly germane to the current duties of that branch, and

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That all legislative officer and senator reports be kept germane to current and future legislation, and

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That any member of ASCSU who wishes to present non-germane information to the body must do so via the weekly informational email.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to Blake Alfred, Speaker of the Senate, Sienna Sasselli, Parliamentarian, Ben Amundson, ASCSU President, Claire Fenton, Chief Justice, and Jessica Dyrdaahl, ASCSU advisor
