ABSTRACT: This bill seeks to allocate funding to sponsor the attendance of US Ambassador Samantha Power in collaboration with the Office of International Programs.

**WHEREAS**

Over the past five years the Associated Students of Colorado State University (ASCSU) and the Office of International Programs (OIP) have collaborated to bring prominent speaking events to campus; and,

**WHEREAS**

In previous years this collaboration has yielded events involving heads of state and noble laureates who have honored the University through their message and presence; and,

**WHEREAS**

The value of these truly unique events belong to all students and ASCSU engagement ensures that campus partners are able to share this experience with the most students and to ensure the continued presence of these events into the future; and,

**WHEREAS**

For the 2019-2020 year, the Office of International Programs in collaboration with on-campus partners would like to bring Samantha Power, the 28th United States Ambassador to the United Nations; and,

WHEREAS

The ASCSU General Discretionary exists to give the ASCSU Senate the flexibility to take advantage of these one-time opportunities that greatly benefit our students; and,

WHEREAS

Because of the diligence of OIP fundraising efforts, they have the support of numerous community partners to provide logistical support and share expenses, reducing the cost requested of ASCSU to \$6,000 which is only about 11% of the total cost of the event; so,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the \$6,000 needed to host US Ambassador Samantha Power be pulled from the ASCSU General Discretionary wherever it may reside and utilized for this event; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

That a copy of this legislation be forwarded to; Ben Amundson, ASCSU President; Shauna DeLuca, Office of International Programs; and Kim Grubbs, ASCSU Administrative Assistant and Advisor.
