ABSTRACT: This bill requests \$50,000 to be moved from the 2020-2021 Board for Student Organization Funding budget to support the RamLink network upgrade.

WHEREAS

According to Article IX, Section 903 of the Constitution of the Associated Students of Colorado State University, "The ASCSU Board for Student Organization Funding shall have responsibility and authority for allocating such funds in a viewpoint neutral manner."; and,

WHEREAS

According to Article IX, Section 905a of the Constitution of the Associated Students of Colorado State University, "The Board for Student Organization Funding shall have the power to establish its own bylaws, rules of order, rules of procedure, and fiscal rules as the members deem necessary, provided that all allocations of the ASCSU Fee shall be done in a viewpoint neutral manner."; and,

WHEREAS

According to Article IX, Section 905b of the Constitution of the Associated Students of Colorado State University, "The Board for Student Organization Funding may approve allocations not to exceed \$14,000 for any one eligible organization. If a specific request exceeds \$14,000 it must be ratified by the Senate through a Bill following the Board's recommendation."; and,

WHEREAS

RamLink is the officially Colorado State University involvement portal with more than 12,000 involved users on the site with more than 500 registered student organizations; and,

WHEREAS

Colorado State University students have experienced three semesters of disruption to their academic and student life due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

WHEREAS

Students will be needing and seeking further opportunities for involvement in both virtual and inperson environments as we transition to summer and fall; and,

WHEREAS

\$50,000 will be allocated to support utility changes of RamLink which will allow for easier accessibility for users, open new opportunities for data-gathering, and enhance overall system features; and,

WHEREAS

The RamLink updates include a budget management system, organization accounting, two-way EMS integration, campus wide election capabilities, an event check-in application, and the ability to better collect, track, and make meaning of involvement at Colorado State University; and,

WHEREAS

These funds will be allocated to the SLiCE Involvement account in order for the funds to be fully utilized; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED
