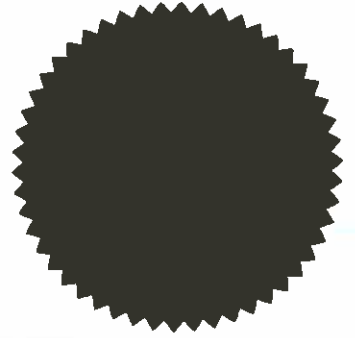

Extension of the Signage Inclusivity Sunset Clause**

ABSTRACT: This Bill seeks to extend the Sunset Clause of Bill 5012 to the end of the Academic year 2023 to allow the project to come to fruition.

WHEREAS

Bill 5012, the Pride Resource Center Pilot Program to Increase Access to Inclusive Restroom Interactive Map, states, "That any money contributed by the ASCSU Discretionary Fund for this project that is not spent by the end of the 2020-2021 Academic Year be returned to the Senate Discretionary Fund for future use"; and,

WHEREAS

Bill 5012, the Pride Resource Center Pilot Program to Increase Access to Inclusive Restroom Interactive Map, states, "That any money contributed by the ASCSU Executive Branch for this project that is not spent by the end of the 2020-2021 Academic Year be returned to the ASCSU Executive Branch for future use"; and,

WHEREAS

The Gender Inclusive Restroom Signage Project is ensuring all accessibility measures are offered, as such, the project could benefit from additional time; and,

WHEREAS

The project specified in Bill 5012 is still ongoing and will not be complete by the end of the 2020-2021 Academic year; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That the Fiftieth Senate of the Associated Students of Colorado State University officially agree to the allocation of funding from Bill 5012: Pride Resource Center Pilot Program to Increase Access to Inclusive Restroom Interactive Map to June of 2023. All remaining funds after June 2023 will be returned to the ASCSU General Discretionary Fund; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED


That the Fiftieth Senate of the Associated Students of Colorado State University continue to officially endorse all efforts made toward creating a more inclusive environment throughout CSU; and,
