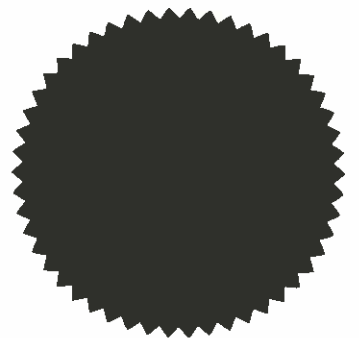

Ensuring Funding of Senate's Legislative Priorities**

ABSTRACT: This bill aims to reallocate \$6,000 from the ASCSU Fund Balance to the ASCSU Senate Discretionary to ensure that Senate can fulfill all of its legislative priorities.

WHEREAS

The ASCSU Senate Discretionary has \$21,516.92 remaining; and,

WHEREAS

Bill 5026: Gender Affirming Garment Bill, which is requesting \$10,000, will be approaching its second reading on May 5, 2021; and,

WHEREAS

Bill 5027: Formation of Social Justice Book Library, which is requesting \$2,500, will be approaching its second reading on May 5, 2021; and,

WHEREAS

Bill 5028: Expanding Students' Access to Outdoor Wi-Fi, which is requesting \$15,000, will be approaching its second reading on May 5, 2021; and,

WHEREAS

If all three (3) pieces of legislation pass, the ASCSU Senate will exceed its spending potential by \$5,983.08; and,

WHEREAS

ASCSU Senate believes that all pieces of legislation should have a fair opportunity to be read, discussed, passed, and funded, since each piece of legislation display a demonstrated impact for the CSU Student Body; so,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That \$6,000 shall be moved from the ASCSU Fund Balance to the ASCSU Senate Discretionary to ensure that all three (3) pieces of legislation have a fair and equal opportunity to pass; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED

Any funds that are not earmarked by May 31, 2021, will automatically roll over from ASCSU Senate Discretionary to the ASCSU Fund Balance; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED
