ABSTRACT: A resolution recognizing the No. 10 ranked CSU Women's Volleyball Team for a 28 game win streak and for qualifying to the NCAA tournament for the 25th year in a row.

WHEREAS

The Colorado State University Women's Volleyball team recently defeated Denver University in a 5 set faceoff, boosting their season record to 29-1, and;

WHEREAS

The CSU Women's Volleyball team is currently ranked 10th in the nation, and;

WHEREAS

The team has qualified for the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Championship Tournament for the 25th year in a row, and;

WHEREAS

#22 CSU Setter Katie Oleksak has been selected as the Mountain West Player of the Year for the 3rd consecutive year with a season total of 137 points, 71 kills, and 1,101 assists, and;

WHEREAS

The CSU Women's Volleyball team has excelled on the court and in the classroom with a teamwide average GPA of 3.74, the second highest GPA average ever recorded by a CSU sports program, and;

WHEREAS

The CSU Women's Volleyball Team has been under the direction of Head Coach Tom Hilbert, Associate Head Coach Emily Kohan, Assistant Coach Adrianna Culbert, and Director of Operations Bri Olmstead, and;

WHEREAS

Head Coach Tom Hilbert, currently in his 23rd year with CSU, has earned 12 Mountain West Coach of the Year awards with a coaching record of 590-135 at CSU, and;

WHEREAS

The team is ranked #23 out of 64 teams in this year's NCAA Tournament, and;

WHEREAS

The 2019 NCAA Tournament will begin on December 6th, 2019 and live coverage of Friday's game can be found at <https://pac-12.com/live/university-washington> starting at 6:00PM (MST) and;
