- Bill #5406 - Endorsing A Letter Concerning Campus Safety
 - First reading
 - Abstract: “This Bill aims to add the endorsement of the Associated Students of Colorado State University to a letter drafted by the College of Liberal Arts Representative Council regarding the transparency of campus safety issues (specifically on October 16th and 22nd 2024).”
 - Emily Reese, President of the College of Liberal Arts Representative Council (CLARC)
 - A lot of students have been confused and concerned by the lack of clarity in the text reports.
 - Speaker Taylor has discussed this a bit with VP Blanche Hughes.
 - It’s a good idea to have ASCSU sign this since ASCSU members can take this back to their constituencies (College Councils and SDPS Offices) and have them sign it as well as individuals.
 - Edit: Sammy Trout wants to endorse.
 - Q & A
 - Chair Davis: How does this letter manage confidentiality?

- The bill is not asking for all details but information that helps advise students if it's safe for them to be on campus and go to classes.
 - Senator Greene: Are you trying to implement a rating scale for the urgency?
 - This can be up to the discretion of the CSU PD and CSU Administration. This letter is to show the issues that students are experiencing with the system as it is now and ask CSU PD and CSU Administration to act. In Speaker Taylor's meeting, a rating scale has at least been discussed.
 - Senator Greene: Is this more a voice of concern rather than a call to action?
 - This is more of a suggestion, yes. It is not our authority to decide how this is handled.
 - Will be sent to University Affairs, DEI Affairs, and Committee Affairs
