**ABSTRACT:** *This resolution affirms ASCSU’s support of immigrant students in face of growing crackdowns and calls on the CSU Administration, Board of Governors, and the State of Colorado to fully support the students of Colorado State University.*

**WHEREAS,**

The current political climate has become incredibly toxic towards immigrants in the United States; and,

**WHEREAS,**

The current presidential administration is in the process of taking widespread, devastating action against immigrants in the United States; and,

**WHEREAS,**

The Associated Students of Colorado State University as an organization has an obligation to fight for and protect our constituents and our principles of equality and inclusivity for all; and,

**WHEREAS,**

Article 1, Section 103 of the ASCSU Constitution defines membership as “Each individual taking at least one credit or is a candidate for a doctoral degree at Colorado State University shall be considered a member of ASCSU, provided that all fees have been paid that are required by their level of enrollment.” a description that includes immigrant fee-paying students at CSU; and,

**WHEREAS,**

Immigrant students represent a vulnerable constituency of ASCSU, and the organization has an obligation to fight on their behalf.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University shall work to support all students, regardless of immigration status; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**

That the CSU Administration, CSU System Board of Governors, and the State of Colorado should not take any action that would assist federal immigration enforcement in targeting students in the State of Colorado and on the campus of Colorado State University; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**

That the CSU Administration should work to prevent federal immigration and law enforcement from making arrests on campus and taking other actions that inhibit the ability of students to feel safe and have a productive learning environment; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**

**RESOLUTION #5408 – Resolution in Support of Immigrant Students**

Specific examples of opposed action include but are not limited to: creating or sharing lists of student immigration status with federal immigration enforcement unless required by law, permitting federal immigration enforcement to enter residence halls, classrooms, and other non-public areas, permitting CSU Police to collaborate with federal immigration enforcement for non-criminal cases, permitting federal deputization of CSU Police for the purpose of immigration enforcement; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**

That the CSU Administration should stand up for its students and continue to provide support services for its immigrant students; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**

That the CSU Administration should work to provide mental health services to fully support immigrant students at CSU; and,

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED**


