ABSTRACT: *This resolution denounces the revocation of visas for international students at Colorado State University by the US Department of State.*

WHEREAS,

As of April 9th, 10 international students at Colorado State University have had their visas revoked by the US Department of State, without warning or reasoning; and,

WHEREAS,

These actions have caused CSU students to undergo rapid and traumatic life changes, interrupting the learning of affected students and forcing them to immediately exit the country and leave behind friends, partners, pets, and property; and,

WHEREAS,

These actions have caused harm to all students at CSU by creating fear in our international student population; SO,

Resolution 5429 – DENOUNCING VISA REVOCATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University firmly oppose the unjustified revocation of visas for international students at Colorado State University; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That the Associated Students of Colorado State University oppose any additional actions by the United States government that harm international students or degrade their collegiate experience; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That the university administration of Colorado State University should continue to use all resources available to support impacted students; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED
