Addition of Campus Community Reports to the Senate Agenda

ABSTRACT: *This Bill amends Article III Section 4A of the ASCSU Bylaws to add “Campus Community Reports” to the Senate agenda directly below “Gallery Input”. This addition allows for a specifically allocated time for any student organization that wishes to share any updates, announcements, or initiatives with the Senate, thereby strengthening the relationship with the broader student body and the representative branch of our student government.*

WHEREAS (1),

Currently there is not a designated time within the Senate agenda for student organizations to directly report their events or give updates to the Senate. While the lack of such a designated time does not actively discourage students outside of those serving within official ASCSU capacities to attend Senate meetings, it also does not adequately encourage their attendance either; and,

WHEREAS (2),

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While students are welcome to attend Senate meetings, there is limited incentive as well as a lack of suitable structure embedded in the Senate Agenda for registered student organizations and thus students of broader interests to directly engage with ASCSU through our established systems of reporting in Senate session; and,

WHEREAS (3),

The addition of *Campus Community Reports* will create a recurring and reliable opportunity for campus registered student organizations, to interact directly with Senate, fostering transparency and collaboration; and,

WHEREAS (4),

The addition of Campus Community Reports will allow Senators to provide updates regarding Registered Student Organizations during this designated time, while ensuring that Senator and Associate Senator Reports remain reserved exclusively for matters directly concerning the Senate and its responsibilities; and,

WHEREAS (5),

Following the 2025 April elections, student engagement with ASCSU remains at a low, which the Fifty-Fifth Senate has repeatedly identified as a priority to improve; and,

WHEREAS (6),

Creating a dedicated space for student beyond the confines of ASCSU's constituency structure interests outside of the guise of the ASCSU's constituencies makeup and their jurisdictions within the Senate agenda aligns with ASCSU's mission to represent and serve all students of Colorado State University; **so,**

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED (1)

That Article III, Section 4A of the ASCSU Bylaws be amended to include the following agenda and read as follows:

"The Senate Agenda Shall include, in the following order:

Agenda

i) Call to Order

ii) Pledge of Allegiance

iii) Land Acknowledgement

iv) Swearing-In of new Senators and Associate Senators

v) Beginning Roll Call

vi) Consent Agenda

vii) Gallery Input

viii) Campus Community Reports

ix) Guest Speakers

x) Executive Reports

xi) Judicial Reports

xii) Legislative Reports

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- i. Officer Reports
- ii. Committee and Caucus Reports
- iii. Senator and Associate Senator Reports”

Campus Community Reports shall serve as time for representatives from student organizations or other campus groups to provide updates, announcements, or feedback to the Senate

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED (2)

That this amendment shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Senate and approval by the Speaker of the Senate; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HERBEY FUTHER ENACTED (3)

That the addition of “Campus Community Reports” to the Senate agenda be advertised by the Assistant Director of Registered Student Organization Affairs in the bi-weekly newsletter to all RSO’s and by other means necessary to ensure all RSO’s are adequately informed; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FUTHER ENACTED (4)

That the Senate Clerk compose all of the reports given during Campus Community Reports, and compose them into a singular report that shall be uploaded to the Senate channel in Teams.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FURTHER ENACTED (5)

That the Senate Agenda be reviewed by the Speaker of the Senate every academic year in hopes that there will be new ways of incorporating student interactions within ASCSU; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FINALLY ENACTED (6)
